 - b. Original movie palace, now hosts a large variety of performing arts and classic films

 - a. 2211 Bonita Dr, 1828 Call 818-548-2000 for tour info
 - b. Historic Park contains the Verdugo Adobe built by Jose Maria Verdugo's grandson Teodoro Verdugo, for Jose's sister, Catalina, circa 1828.

 - b. Cultural landmark and landscape celebrating relationship of sister cities Glendale and Higashi-Osaka, Japan.

 - a. 2713 Honolulu Ave, 1926
 - b. Womens mental health facility known for progressive treatment practices

 - b. Victorian home of early Glendale booster, socialite, and railroad developer, Edgar D. Goode.

 - b. Home of early pioneer, founder of Tropicco, donor of railroad land, W.C.B. Richardson
10. *Southern Pacific Railroad Depot (Glendale Transportation Center)
 - a. 400 W. Cerritos Ave, , 1923 https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Glendale_Transportation_Center
 - b. Rail transportation hub, original structure built 1876, replaced 1923.
11. *Grand Central Air Terminal

 - b. Celebrated history-laden airport terminal, built in 1923, is now restored and owned by Disney.
